Citizens Memorial Hospital (CMH) is a rural healthcare system that has achieved recognized success through electronic health record (EHR) adoption and use. The CMH system includes one rural hospital, six long term care facilities, home care, hospice,

10 rural health clinics and 18 specialty physician clinics all using the same EHR system with one record for each patient. Paper medical records have been eliminated and providers use CPOE across the continuum.

CMH recognition includes:

- HIMSS Davies Award of Excellence in 2005 in the Organizational Category
- A Most Wired hospital by Hospitals & Health Networks every year since 2005
- HIMSS Analytics Stage 7 Hospital in 2010, the first rural hospital to reach this stage
- Qualification for Medicare and Medicaid EHR incentive payments for Meaningful Use in 2011

Denni McColm, CIO for CMH, will discuss their EHR journey, including successes, challenges and lessons learned. Denni will also discuss the specific challenges related to qualifying for Meaningful Use incentive payments from the perspective of a rural hospital system.
